Žďár nad Sázavou Estate, Czech Republic, 12-14 September 2016

Type of event:

A two-days participatory workshop based on case studies where discussion has an important place.

Dates: 12-13 September 2016 with an optional visit on 14 September. The workshop will officially end on the evening of the second day and the third day will consist of a field trip.

Organizers:

The seminar will be co-organized by the Grands Sites de France Network (RGSF) and the Žd'ár nad Sázavou Estate.

- The Grands Sites de France Network (RGSF), http://www.grandsitedefrance.com is an association, bringing together local authorities responsible for both day-to-day operations and long term evolution of landscape heritage sites in France. Since 2010, it is in charge of the International Centre for training and exchange of francophone heritage site managers http://www.polepatrimoine.org. It organizes trainings in integrated management of heritage sites and field workshops, coordinates a network of online exchanges and accompanies international cooperation projects between sites.
- The Žd'ár estate, owned by the Kinsky family, includes a complex of Cistercian buildings, the chateau and its dependencies, a basilica, the oldest primary school in Žd'ár region as well as a base of local volunteers firefighters. The origins of the city of Žd'ár can be found here, in a former Cistercian monastery dating back to the 13th century, which later became the Žd'ár estate. The estate is located in vicinity to the Zelená Hora WHS. The Kinsky family contacted other local stakeholders to interest and involve them in a joint project for the reconstruction and revitalization of the entire complex and launch local development dynamics. The New Generation Museum opened its doors in the summer of 2015. A new museum concept for the Czech Republic presenting the Cistercian Order and the Baroque Era, it combines audiovisual aids and historical contents and exhibits and it is a key to understanding the entire complex of the former monastery and today's Žd'ár Estate. http://www.zamekzdar.cz/en/

This event is organised in association with the French national association of WHS, Grand Site de France Bibracte-Mont Beuvray and INCA Architectes as well as partners of the RGSF's International Centre.

Demands for patronage from UNESCO and from the Czech Ministry for Culture for the event are under preparation.

Goals:

- Use the positive friction of cultures and a variety of approaches to develop the integrated management of heritage sites.
- Stimulate a dynamic of cooperation and sharing among different heritage stakeholders in Central and Eastern Europe, esp. sites managers.
- Imagine new models of funding and new ways of managing heritage sites at a time when the availability of public money is reduced.
